

Trans-Pecos Association of Student Councils Class of 2024 Scholarship Application

The Trans-Pecos Association of Student Councils will recognize up to five graduating seniors with college scholarships, <u>up to</u> \$750 each.

Students must meet the following criteria to be considered:

- Must be classified as a graduating senior.
- Must have been involved in student council at their current high school for a minimum of two consecutive years.
- Must have a minimum GPA of an 85.
- Must fully complete scholarship application and submit required attachments by 9 AM on February 23, 2024. Applications must be turned in at Notebook Verification.

Scholarship winners will be notified at Spring Convention. Winners will need to complete the following steps to claim their scholarship:

- Enroll at an accredited institution of higher education during the summer or fall following high school graduation (unless extraordinary circumstances exist)
- Submit proof of enrollment at institution of higher education (either copy of class schedule or tuition balance) to <u>district9stuco@gmail.com</u> no later than October 1st (following their high school graduation)

Upon verification of enrollment, the District Treasurer will send payment directly to the institution of higher education. Payment will not be sent to the student. Failure to complete the above steps may result in forfeiture of the scholarship.

**If a student council member from District IX is awarded a scholarship by TASC at the Annual Conference, District IX will match the scholarship.

National	1 point each
